The Richmond Zine Fest began in 2007 with a goal to create a network among current zine writers and folks who own distros and to raise awareness about and encourage the creation of zines, along with promoting independent press, and other DIY projects in Richmond. This year's zine fest will be a weekend-long event, starting with a First Friday gallery show November 6th, that will feature a zine show as well as tablers from across the nation as far as NYC and Portland, Oregon, Zine related artwork, readings, and live music.

Call For Artwork

Richmond Zine Fest and Gallery5 are seeking art submissions for the First Friday art exhibit on November 6th. Art will be displayed through the end of November. Although we would like art submissions in a variety of forms (print, photography, craft, sculpture, etc.), it is important to us that the artists are involved in zines and DIY publishing. It is not required that the artists table at the Richmond Zine Fest and event participants will not receive special consideration during the selection process.

Gallery5 is a community oriented, socially motivated art gallery and performing arts center located in Richmond's Historic Jackson Ward. Our mission is to transcend the artistic boundaries in our community by providing a unique visual and performing arts center, open to ideas and artists that promote positive social action and innovative artistic expression.
